RESOLUTION NO. 1 FOR
1953

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 That the following persons be and they are hereby appointed to the offices hereinafter set opposite their names for a period of two years beginning with January 1, 1953, and terminating on December 31, 1954.

Section 2 That the officer hereby appointed to perform the duties of City Recorder and City Treasurer as provided for in the Charter of the City of Lebanon shall be known as the City Recorder-Treasurer of the City of Lebanon. Provided, however, that if at any time during her term of office the City Council deems it advisable to appoint an officer to perform the duties of the office of the Treasurer, after such appointment, the officer appointed by this Resolution to perform the duties of recorder and treasurer shall be known as the City Recorder and shall perform only the duties of the City Recorder.
