

RESOLUTION No. 5 FOR 1953

WHEREAS conditions have arisen which dispense with any further necessity of accumulation or expense of money from the Swimming Pool Sinking Fund and

WHEREAS there is an approx. balance of \$12,287.96 in the Swimming Pool Sinking Fund which should be transferred to the General Fund.

Now therefore be it resolved and declared that conditions have arisen and now exist which dispense with the necessity of further accumulation or expenditure of money from the Swimming Pool Sinking Fund for the purpose for which it was voted and the Recorder-Treasurer is authorized to make the following transfer:

Balance of Swimming Pool Sinking Fund at June 30, 1953 and any subsequent receipts, to the General Fund. (Per Sec.6, O.C.L.A. 45 Chapter 453.)
