

RESOLUTION ADVERTISING SALE OF FURNITURE )  
NOW IN CITY OF LEBANON'S HOUSING PROJECT )

RESOLUTION NO. 17  
for 1955

WHEREAS, the Commons Council of the City of Lebanon has by Resolution resolved to dispose of the housing project, now owned by the City of Lebanon, and has heretofore sold certain portions of said housing project, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon now has on hand certain quantities of furniture and furnishings of said housing project now stored in apartments of the housing project, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

That the Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby directed to advertise as prescribed by law for the sale of all of the furniture now stored in the City of Lebanon's housing project to the highest and best bidder for cash and said advertisement provide that all bids be placed with the City Recorder not later than 5:00 p.m., on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of JUNE, 1955, and that said bids be opened by the Common Council at its regular meeting at 8:00 o'clock p.m., on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of JUNE, 1955, and the City Attorney is hereby directed to prepare bid forms requiring at least 10% of the amount bid paid by either certified check, cashier's check and that said successful bidder be required to pay the balance in cash within five days after his bid is accepted.
