

RESOLUTION ADVERTISING SALE OF FURNITURE
NOW OWNED BY CITY OF LEBANON

RESOLUTION NO. 215 1955

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon has by resolution resolved to dispose of the housing project now owned by the City of Lebanon, and has heretofore sold certain portions of said project, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon has previously sold portion of said furniture and

WHEREAS, the balance of the Housing Project is at this time being readied for sale and the city has certain other furniture on hand, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

That the City Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby directed to advertise as prescribed by law for the sale of all the furniture now located in the existing units of the City of Lebanon's Housing Project to the highest and the best bidder for cash, and said advertisement provided that all bids be placed with the City Recorder not later than 5:00 oclock p.m. on the 19TH of July, 1955, and that said bids be opened by the Common Council at its regular meeting at 8:00 oclock p.m. on the 19TH of July 1955 and that said notice of sale require at least 10% of the ammount of the bid paid by either cash, certified check, or cashiers check and that the successfull bidder be required to pay the balance in cash within 5 days after the bid is accepted.

Passed by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor on the 21ST June, 1955.
