RESOLUTION NO. 24 _____
for 1955

WHEREAS, the parking problem has become acute in the vicinity of
Main Street and West Ash Street, and


WHEREAS, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended
that the time limit for parking in said area be further limited,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That pursuant to the power given to it by Ordinance Bill No. 4,
for 1947, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 6th day
of May 1947, known as Ordinance No. 641, is hereby declared that immediately
the first parking space on the South side of Ash street lying West of Main
Street be limited to 12 minutes and that a meter, more commonly known as
a 12 minute parking meter, be forthwith installed to that effect and from
said 12 minute meter along the South side of Ash Street West to the first
alley, parking be limited to 30 minutes, and that parking meters be forth-
with installed that shall register only 30 minutes, save and except, places
which shall be reserved for loading only.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on this 19th, day
of July, 1955.
