

RESOLUTION FOR THE REZONING OF CERTAIN  
PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF LEBANON

Resolution No. 4

for 1956

WHEREAS, it appears to the Common Council that certain property lying within the City of Lebanon that is zoned as "ZONE 2 - RESIDENTIAL" should be zoned "ZONE 3 - BUSINESS" for the reason that the present boundary line divides certain business lots making the back portion of them useless, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That the Planning Commission be, and hereby is, directed to hold a public hearing in regard to such proposed rezoning. Said public hearing to be held at the City Hall at 8:00 o'clock P.M., March 19, 1956, and that notice of said proposed rezoning be published in the "LEBANON EXPRESS", a newspaper other than a daily newspaper, published within the City of Lebanon, Oregon, and within general circulation therein, giving the citizens of Lebanon and other interested persons an opportunity to be heard upon rezoning from "Zone 2- Residential" to "Zone 3- Business" of the following described real property, to-wit:

Beginning on the South line of "E" Street at a point which is West 189 feet from the center line of Main Street, said point being South 60 feet from the Southwest corner of Lot 1, Morris Addition, and running thence West along the South line of "E" Street 41.00 feet, thence South parallel to the center line of Main Street 287.50 feet, thence East 4.70 Feet, thence South parallel to the center line of Main Street and West 225.30 feet therefrom to the Southeast corner of Santa Barbara-Zeitler Addition, thence West 63.80 feet, thence South parallel to the center line of Main Street 296.30 feet, thence East 25.08 feet to a point West 264.00 feet from the center line of Main Street, thence South parallel to said street line to the South boundary of the City, thence Easterly along said boundary to a point West 189.00 feet from the center line of Main Street, thence North parallel to the center line of Main Street to the place of beginning.

and the Planning Commission of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, is hereby directed to make its findings and to file them with the Clerk of the Council, to-wit:

The City Recorder on or before 7:00 o'clock P.M. March 20, 1956.
