RESOLUTION NO. 20  
for 1957

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35 of Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has caused to have erected certain electric stop and go signs and signals controlling pedestrian traffic at certain intersections, which is reasonable and necessary for the regulation and safety of traffic within the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

That the automatic electric stop and go signals and pedestrian wait-walk signals now erected or to be erected at the intersection where Milton Street runs East from South Main Street and "E" Street runs West from South Main Street, is hereby designated as legally adopted by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon and are hereby declared to be approved by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon and from this date forward is made part of the traffic ordinances of the City of Lebanon.
