


FOR THE ADOPTION OF CERTAIN STOP
SIGNS AS PART OF THE TRAFFIC
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON.

RESOLUTION NO. 30
for 1957.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35, Ordinance Number 567, the street committee of the common council has recommended certain additional stop signs at certain intersections within the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL, that the following stop signs, which are either now erected or to be erected, to-wit:
On A Street on both sides of Williams Street, on Filbert Street where it intersects with Milton Street, on both ends of the alley that runs from Milton Street to Main Street, be and hereby are, directed to be approved by the common council of the City of Lebanon and are hereby directed to be part of the traffic Ordinances of the City of Lebanon.
