

A RESOLUTION ORDERING PROPERTY OWNER(S) TO
CONSTRUCT SIDEWALK ALONG EAST SIDE OF SECOND
STREET FROM INTERSECTION OF COX STREET
EXTENDING NORTH 148 FEET.


RESOLUTION NO. 8

for 1957

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON that the property owner, or owners, owning the property along the East side of Second Street, Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, from the intersection of Cox Street extending North 148 feet be, and hereby are, ordered to construct the sidewalk along the East side of Second Street from Cox Street North, a distance of approximately 148 feet. Said sidewalk shall be 5 feet wide, made of concrete of not less than five sack mix and shall be not less than 4 inches thick, and that said sidewalk shall be built within 30 days from the passage of this resolution.

The Street Superintendent and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to give notice to the adjacent property owner, or owners, as prescribed in Section 223 of the Charter of the City of Lebanon.
