
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That the property owner or owners owning the property along the West side of Main Street in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon from the Southeast corner of Lot 2, ~~Block~~ Morris Addition to the City of Lebanon, ~~Block~~ North to the Northeast corner of Lot 3, ~~Block~~, Morris Addition to the City of Lebanon; along the West side of Main Street from the Southeast corner of Lot 6, ~~Block~~, Morris Addition to the City of Lebanon, North to the Northeast corner of Lot 6, ~~Block~~, Morris Addition to the City of Lebanon; be and hereby are ordered to construct a sidewalk in said area.

Said sidewalk shall be 5 feet wide, made of concrete of not less than 4" thick and said sidewalk shall be built within 30 days from the passage of this Resolution in accordance with Ordinance No. 586 as amended by Ordinance No. 766.

The Street Superintendent and the Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to give notice to the adjacent property owners as prescribed in Chapter VIII, Section 223 of the Charter of the City of Lebanon.
