

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING "H" STREET }
IN THE CITY OF LEBANON.

RESOLUTION NO. 10
for 1959.

WHEREAS, certain property has been deeded to the City of Lebanon by L. E. Arnold and Clara P. Arnold for the purposes of establishing a street, and

WHEREAS, homes are now being built adjacent to this property and it is necessary for the public health, safety and welfare that a street be established,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon that the following described property be established and designated as "H" Street, in the City of Lebanon:

Beginning at a 3/4" Iron pipe on the Easterly line of South Second Street, said Iron pipe being S. 7° 30.5' W. 262.04 feet from the Southwest corner of Santa Barbara-Zeitler Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; and running thence N. 7° 30.5' E. along the Easterly line of Second Street 44.35 feet to a 1" Iron pipe, thence S. 89° 38' E. parallel to the South line of the William Ralston D.L.C. No. 48, a distance of 305.91 feet to a 1" Iron pipe, thence S. 0° 09' W. 44.00 feet to a 1" Iron pipe, thence N. 89° 38' W. 311.63 feet to the place of beginning, this conveyance being for street purposes.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 4th day of August, 1959.
