IN THE MATTER OF THE STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE WIDENING OF GRANT STREET from MAIN to PARK; and EXTENDING BINSHADLER FOR A DISTANCE OF TWENTY NINE FEET EAST OF THE END OF THE PRESENT PAVED PORTION OF SAID STREET.

RESOLUTION NO. 11 for 1963

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has filed herein plans, specifications and estimates for the street improvement district for the widening of Grant Street from Main to Park; and extending Binshadler for a distance of twenty-nine feet east of the end of the present paved portion of said street, in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said plans, specifications and estimates, including the probable total cost of said improvements and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being the property especially benefitted thereby, and the amount thereof to be borne by the City, be and they are in all respects, approved, ratified and affirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said improvements be, and they are hereby, declared to be necessary and proper and for the best interest of the City of Lebanon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Recorder shall cause such notice of intention to make said improvements to be given as provided by the Charter of the City of Lebanon, said notice to be given by posting notices thereof in five public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days, or by publication of said notice in a newspaper in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days.
