WHEREAS, there has been no designation for the cities of Lebanon and Sweet Home on the directional sign for southbound traffic at the intersection of U.S. Highway 20 and Interstate Freeway 5, and there have been many instances where traffic travelling to Lebanon and Sweet Home has missed the turnoff because of lack of directional designation as many motorists are unfamiliar with the South Santiam; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany is agreeable to the removal of the name "Albany" from said sign and the City Council of Sweet Home and the Sweet Home-East Linn Chamber of Commerce have previously submitted requests for the addition of the names of Lebanon and Sweet Home to the sign;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, hereby requests the Oregon State Highway Department to change the name designation of the directional sign for southbound traffic at the intersection of U.S. Highway 20 and Interstate Freeway 5 by the removal of the name "Albany", and the addition of the mames "Lebanon" and "Sweet Home".
