## RESOLUTION NO. 2 for 1963

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> That whereas, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs at the intersections of Grove and Isabella Streets and Grove and Ash Streets, requiring the traffic on Grove Street to stop at said intersections, in the City of Lebanon, which is reasonable and necessary for the regulation and safety of traffic.

Now, therefore, stop signs shall be erected on Grove Street on both sides of Isabella Street, and on Grove Street on both sides of Ash Street, and Grove Street, at its intersection with Isabella Street is declared to be a stop street and Grove Street at its intersection with Ash Street is declared to be a stop street and such designations are part of the traffic ordinances of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
