RESOLUTION NO. 17
for 1964

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon is now lighted by 16,000 lumen lamps, pursuant to a contract with Pacific Power & Light Company dated February 17, 1959; and WHEREAS the said lamps are no longer available and the conversion to 21,000 lumen mercury-vapor lamps is necessary; and WHEREAS the rate for said brighter lights is \$5.00 per month, which rate the City will be expected to pay beginning with its next fiscal year, although said larger lights may be installed in substitution for the smaller lights prior to the beginning of the next fiscal year,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Contract dated February 17, 1959, between City of Lebanon and Pacific Power & Light Company be amended to provide the following:

- (a) Company shall, as soon as practicable after the date hereof, convert each of the 265 existing 16,000 lumen mercury-vapor street lights in the City of Lebanon to 21,000 lumen mercury-vapor street lights of the vertical type.
- (b) From the effective date hereof, wood distribution poles used to support mercury-vapor street lights or circuits used exclusively for mercury-vapor street lighting shall not be subject to the pole charges specified in Section 3 of said Contract.
- (c) City, subject to the approval of its Budget Committee, shall pay at the rate of \$5.00 per month for service from each such converted street light, commencing July 1, 1965.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 20th day of October, 1964.
