A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS AND PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS. RESOLUTION NO. <u>/6</u> for 1965

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

)

<u>Section 1.</u> That whereas, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs, (1) on Grove Street at the intersection with Carolina Street requiring the traffic on Grove Street to stop at said intersection; (2) on Hiatt Street and Cleveland Street at their intersections with Isabella Street, requiring the traffic on Hiatt Street and on Cleveland Street to stop at their intersections with Isabella Street; and (3) on Sherman Street at its intersection with Grove Street requiring the traffic on Sherman Street to stop at its intersection with Grove Street, and whereas such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, stop signs shall be erected, (1) on Grove Street at its intersection with Carolina Street, and Grove Street be at said intersection is declared to/a stop street; (2) on Hiatt Street and Cleveland Street at their intersections with Isabella Street, and Hiatt Street and Cleveland Street at said intersections are declared to be stop streets; and (3) on Sherman Street at its intersection with Grove Street, and Sherman Street at said intersection is declared to be a stop street; and such designations are part of the traffic ordinances of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
