RESOLUTION NO. 3  
for 1965

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That whereas, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of a stop sign on West Rose Street at the intersection with 10th Street, requiring the traffic on West Rose Street to stop at said intersection, and whereas such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, a stop sign shall be erected on West Rose Street at its intersection with 10th Street; and West Rose Street at said intersection is declared to be a stop street; and such designations are part of the traffic ordinances of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 16th day of February, 1965.
