

RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION)
OF A RIGHT-TURN-ONLY SIGN.)

RESOLUTION NO. 4
for 1965

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. That whereas, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of one or more "Right-Turn-Only" signs facing west on the west side of south Main Street suitably placed for visibility at the exits from Ritchie's Drive-in and Honda business establishment so as to prevent vehicles from entering Main Street and turning left from said exits, and requiring vehicles leaving said areas to turn right only upon entering Main Street from said areas, and whereas such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, "Right-Turn-Only" signs shall be erected on the west boundary of south Main Street facing Ritchie's Drive-In and the Honda business enterprise at the exits from said areas onto south Main Street; and vehicles leaving said areas are hereby required to turn to the right only and are prohibited from turning to the left on south Main Street; and such designations and regulations are part of the traffic ordinances of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 2nd day of March, 1965.
