RESOLUTION NO. 10  
for 1966

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Cleveland Street at its intersection with Oak Street requiring the traffic on Cleveland Street to stop at said intersection with Oak Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Stop signs shall be erected on Cleveland Street at its intersection with Oak Street, and Cleveland Street at said intersection is declared to be a stop street; and such designations are part of the traffic ordinances of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
