A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CERTAIN
"NO PARKING" ZONES ON HIGHWAY 20,
WHEELERSTREET, AND WILLIAMS STREET
AS PART OF THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS
OF THE CITY OF LEBANON

RESOLUTION NO. for 1967

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35, Ordinance 567, the Street
Committee of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon,
has recommended that parking be eliminated (1) on the west side
of Highway 20 from Morton Street north to the south driveway entrance
into Dairy Queen lot; (2) on the south side of Wheeler Street, from
Main Street east to the alley; (3) on the north side of Wheeler
Street from Williams Street centerline west a distance of 100 feet;
and (4) on the east side of Williams Street from its intersection
with Wheeler Street south a distance of 100 feet; and

WHEREAS such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of  $^{\rm L}$ ebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The west side of Highway 20 from Morton Street north to the south driveway entrance into Dairy Queen lot is a "No Parking" zone; the south side of Wheeler Street from Main Street east to the alley is a "No Parking" zone; the north side of Wheeler Street from Williams Street centerline west a distance of 100 feet is a "No Parking" zone; and the east side of Williams Street from its intersection with Wheeler Street south a distance of 100 feet is a "No Parking" zone; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
