RESOLUTION NO. 11
for 1967

WHEREAS the Common Council of the City of Lebanon did, on May 16, 1967, pass Ordinance No. 1257, providing for the regulating of Ambulance Service and providing that the official tariff rates and charges should be established by Resolution of the Common Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

That the official tariff rates and charges governing ambulances operated within the City of Lebanon are as follows:

AMBULANCE RATES

Starting Fee	\$26.00
Plus:	
metered rate computed as follows:	
\$1.00 per mile or fraction thereof from point of pickup to patient's destination, or \$20.00 per hour that the ambulance equipment is in operation. First 15 minutes of waiting time shall not be charged.	
Stairs, per flight of 5 or more steps	2.00
Splints, per splint	2.00
First Aid supplies, per patient	2.00
Restraints	5.00
Emergency trip, per patient	5.00
Oxygen, 20% of metered rate	
Resuscitator, per patient	10.00
Aspiration, per patient	5.00
Contagious disease patient	10.00
Mentally disturbed patient	5.00
Traveling off of properly maintained public roads	5.00
Plane, train, or boat load or unload	5.00
Service charge, if not paid within 30 days after date of billing	5.00

Multi-patient, each stretcher patient shall be charged the metered rate plus any additional charges for services required. Each Sit-up patient shall be charged one-half the metered rate plus any additional charges for services required. There must be one full charge per ambulance trip.

No patient trips, full charge less 10%.

Out of town transfers, \$26.00 to start and \$1.00 per mile for the first 50 miles and then \$0.65 per mile to the patient's destination.

Added charge of \$10.00 to patient served in an area outside the boundaries of the City of Lebanon.

(If the Lebanon Rural Fire Protection District participates in the ambulance program, then there shall be no added charge for patients served within the District.)
