RESOLUTION NO. 12  
for 1967

WHEREAS the Common Council of the City of Lebanon did, on May 16, 1967, pass Ordinance No. 1257 providing for the regulating of Ambulance Service and providing for the establishment of a minimum standard equipment list by Resolution adopted by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS it is necessary, pursuant to the provisions of the above mentioned Ordinance, for the Common Council to establish by Resolution approval of a minimum standard equipment list,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

That the following minimum standard equipment list shall be effective as of JUNE 16 1967, and shall be required of each ambulance ~~and invalid or wheelchair coach~~ operated in the City of Lebanon:

EQUIPMENT LIST (Minimum Standard)

A. Radio Equipment

1. Two-way radio- between office dispatcher and ambulance

B. Safety Equipment

1. All seats shall be provided with seat belts.
2. Two hard hats
3. Fire extinguisher (dry chemical type)
4. Germicidal light or            disinfectant SPRAY
5. Three road flares (20min. type)
6. Two flashlights
7. One hand spotlight
8. Two car mounted spotlights
9. Auto jack and tire wrench
10. One tachograph recording device

C. Stretchers

1. One (1) cot with variable position back rest, all rubber tired wheels, variable standing levels, contour features, one set safety belts, locking bar, and foam mattress and pillow.
2. Three auxiliary hinged cots with locking wheels and legs, one set of safety belts per cot, and six hanging hooks.
3. One fracture stretcher (canvas type)

D. Blankets and Linen

1. Four blankets
2. Linen for main cot (per car)
  - a. 6 cot sheets
  - b. 6 pillow cases
  - c. 4 head towels
  - d. 2 large sheets

MEDICAL EQUIPMENT

I. Oxygen and resuscitation equipment

- A. oxygen system in sound operating condition with a minimum of one hour of oxygen at the rate of 6L per minute

1. easily cleaned or disposable oxygen masks (adult & child size)
2. 2 oropharyngeal airways (adult & child size)
3. 2 2-way resuscitative airways

- B. a resuscitation <sup>CR</sup> of standard brand capable of inhalation and aspiration

II. Splint boards

- A. 2 arm splints (padded with a minimum width of 4" and length 18")
- B. 2 leg splints (padded 4" wide, 35" long)
- C. 1 balloon type arm splint
- D. 1 balloon type leg splint
- E. 2 sandbags 2" x 4" x 12"

III. FIRST AID SUPPLIES

- A. 6 compress dressings (8" x 10")
- B. 2 doz. 4 x 4 sterile gauze pads individually wrapped
- C. 3 - 3" gauze bandages  
3 - 6" Ace bandages  
3 - 4" Ace bandages
- D. adhesive tape - roll each of 1", 2", 3"
- E. 2 tourniquets either 1" latex or rubber
- F. mouth gag - 3 tongue blades taped together and padded
- G. 2 pair bandage scissors
- H. one kidney (emesis) basin
- I. battery operated lantern
- J. restraint straps with buckle

IV. TOOLS

1. Pry - bar
2. Hack saw
