A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS AND PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS.

RESOLUTION NO. 2/ for 1967

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Third Street and on Fourth Street at their intersections with W. Grant Street, requiring the traffic on Third Street and Fourth Street to stop at said intersections with W. Grant Street; and

WHEREAS such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Third Street and on Fourth Street at their intersections with W. Grant Street, and Third Street and Fourth Street at said respective intersections with W. Grant Street are declared to be stop streets; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
