

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FOUR-HOUR
PARKING ON PORTIONS OF HIATT, E. GRANT,
AND CLEVELAND STREETS.

RESOLUTION NO. 22
for 1967

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35, Ordinance 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon has recommended that a four-hour parking zone be established on both sides of Hiatt Street between the Lebanon-Santiam Canal and E. Grant Street; on both sides of E. Grant Street between Hiatt and Cleveland Streets; and on both sides of Cleveland Street between E. Grant and E. Sherman Streets, whereupon it shall be unlawful to park a vehicle in said zone for more than four hours in any day; and

WHEREAS such regulation is deemed to be ^areasonable and necessary regulation of vehicles and traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the parking strip on both sides of Hiatt Street between the Lebanon-Santiam canal and E. Grant Street, on both sides of E. Grant Street between Hiatt Street and Cleveland Street, and on both sides of Cleveland Street between E. Grant Street and E. Sherman Street is a "four-hour parking" zone; and it shall be unlawful to park a vehicle in said area for more than four hours in any one ^{hour} twenty-four_{hour} period; and such designation and regulation is part of the traffic and vehicle regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
