A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP ON THIRD STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH ROSE STREET AND PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS. RESOLUTION NO. 30 for 1967

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Third Street at its intersection with Rose Street, requiring the traffic on Third Street to stop at its intersections with Rose Street; and

WHEREAS such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Third Street at its intersections with Rose Street, and Third Street at said intersections with Rose Street are declared to be abstop street; and such designation is part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
