RESOLUTION NO. 32 for 1967

WHEREAS the territory described below is completely surrounded by the
City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS ORS 222.750 provides that such territory, completely surrounded
by the corporate limits of a city, may be annexed by the City by Resolution,
subject to referendum, with or without the consent of any owner of property
within the territory or resident in the territory,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

That the territory described as follows:

which is completely surrounded by the corporate limits of the City of
Lebanon, be and the same hereby is annexed to and henceforth is a part
of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

Beginning at the intersection of the present Southerly Boundary of the City of Lebanon with the West boundary of Second Street. (Said intersection being near the North line of H Street) thence; South $7^{\circ}30\frac{1}{2}'$ West 300 ft. to the South line of I Street; thence West 185 ft; thence South 216.75 ft. thence East 156.43 ft. to the West line of Second Street; thence South $7^{\circ}30\frac{1}{2}'$ West along the West line of Second Street 490 feet to its' intersection with the Southline of Airport Road, thence West along the South line of Airport Road to the East line of Fifth Street; Thence South on the East line of Fifth Street 320 feet; thence East 105.96 ft; thence North 15 ft. more or less to the Southwest corner of the Harry M. Olson property as described on page 9 of Linn County Deed Volume 238; thence South $89^{\circ}41'$ East 381.6 ft. thence North 85.33 ft. thence North $83^{\circ}12'$ East 254.49 ft. to the Eastline of Second Street; thence South $8^{\circ}39'$ East 25 feet more or less to the Northwest corner of that property conveyed to Daniel L. and Esther B. Burris thence North $89^{\circ}58'$ East 118.48 ft. to the Northeast corner of said Burris Property; thence North 105 feet more or less to a point which bears South $89^{\circ}24'$ West 34 feet from the Southwest corner of that certain tract conveyed to Peggy Patchell by Deed recorded on page 10 Volume 166 of Linn County Deed Records; thence North $89^{\circ}24'$ East 142 ft. thence South 75 feet more or less to the Southeast corner of that certain property conveyed to Karlos S. and Virginia R. Maki on Page 80 Volume 318 Linn County Deed Records; thence East 118 ft. thence North 90 feet more or less to the Northwest corner of that certain tract conveyed to Thomas E. Gates by deed recorded on page 597 of Volume 299 of Linn County Deed Records; thence East 134.5 ft. thence North 170.3 ft. to the North line of Airport Road; thence West 134.86 ft. North along the West line of that tract of land conveyed to Harris Distributing Company by Deed recorded on Page 628 of Volume 271 of Linn County Deed Records to the Southwesterly right-of-way of the Lebanon Santiam Canal; thence Northwesterly along said right-of-way 350 feet more or less to a point which bears West of the most Westerly corner of that tract of land conveyed by Richard M. Peters et al by deed recorded on Page 407 of Volume 261 of Linn County Deed Records; thence East along the extension West and the North line of said Peters tract 290 ft. more or less to the present boundary of the City of Lebanon; thence Northwesterly to the place of beginning.
