A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP AT CERTAIN INTERSECTIONS AND PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS. RESOLUTION NO. 5
for 1967

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs as follows: (1) on Milton Street at its intersection with the east line of the Oregon Electric Railway right-of-way, stopping west bound traffic on Milton Street; and (2) on Wheeler Street at its intersection with Williams Street, stopping the west bound traffic on Wheeler Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Stop signs shall be erected (1) on Milton Street at its intersection with the east line of the Oregon electric Railway right-of-way, for the purpose of stopping west bound traffic on Milton Street, and said street at said intersection for traffic traveling in a west bound direction is declared to be a stop street; and (2) on Wheeler Street at its intersection with Williams Street, for the purpose of stopping west bound traffic on Wheeler Street, and said street at said intersection for traffic traveling in a west bound direction is declared to be a stop street; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 21st day of February, 1967.
