WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Lebanon deem it to be reasonable and proper to afford the electors of the city an opportunity to adopt a Council-Manager form of government, it is, therefore, necessary that the Council submit to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon at the election to be held Tuesday, November 5, 1968, for their adoption or rejection, the proposed new Charter and repeal of the existing Charter, effective July 1, 1969.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. That there shall be submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon for their approval or rejection at a special election to be held on November 5, 1968, the date of the State General Election, the following:

PROPOSITION

Shall the legal electors of the City of Lebanon repeal the provisions of the existing Charter of the City of Lebanon, and all amendments thereto, and adopt the proposed new City Charter establishing a Council-Manager form of government, to take effect July 1, 1969.

Section 2. That said proposal for adoption of the new Charter and repeal of the old one shall be placed on the official ballot by the City Recorder; and he is hereby authorized and directed to publish and post notices of said election in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. That the polling places, clerks and judges of the election and the manner of conducting said election shall be as provided by law and city ordinance.

Section 4. That the ballots to be used by the electors at said election shall contain, in addition to the ballot title and proposition,

the words "For new charter and repeal of old", and "Against new charter and repeal of old".

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 17th day of September, 1968.
