WHEREAS, a general movement appears to be underway in the State of Oregon to abolish or curtail Justice's Courts and to limit the jurisdiction and powers of said Courts and Municipal Courts; and

WHEREAS, any curtailment or the abolition of the power or the dimunition of the jurisdiction of these Courts would be burdensome and disadvantageous to the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Common Council of the City of Lebanon opposes the recommendation of the Governor's Committee and persons who would eliminate or interfere with the present states and power of Justice's and Municipal Courts so far as they effect the City of Lebanon and Linn County.
