RESOLUTION NO. 7
for 1968

WHEREAS the City Engineer has filed herein plans, specifications and estimates for the sewer improvement district for the construction of lateral sewers in Airport Road from 7th Street to Highway 20; in 5th Street from Airport Road North to G Street; in 5th Street from Airport Road South approximately 700 feet; in Second Street from Airport Road South Approximately 400 feet; from Walker Road North and East to serve parts of Gronso's First, Second and Third Additions; from Walker Road North and East across Highway 20 to Primrose Avenue,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said plans, specifications and estimates, including the probable total cost of said improvements and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being the property especially benefitted thereby, and the amount thereof to be borne by the City, be and they are in all respects approved, ratified and affirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said improvements be and they are hereby declared to be necessary and proper and for the best interests of the City of Lebanon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder shall cause such notice of intention to make said improvements to be given as provided by the Charter of the City of Lebanon, said notice to be given by posting notices thereof in five public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days, or by publication of said notice in a newspaper in the City of Lebanon, for a period of ten days.
