

A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP ON WHEELER STREET AT WILLIAMS STREET FOR EAST BOUND TRAFFIC WITH RIGHT TURN PERMITTED WITHOUT STOPPING, AND REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP ON WILLIAMS STREET AT MILTON STREET WITH RIGHT TURN PERMITTED WITHOUT STOPPING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS.


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Wheeler Street at its intersection with Williams Street, requiring the traffic on Wheeler Street to stop at said intersection, with a right turn permitted without stopping; and for the erection of stop signs on Williams Street at its intersection with Milton Street, requiring the traffic on Williams Street to stop at said intersection, with a right turn permitted without stopping; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Wheeler Street at its intersection with Williams Street, on both the east and west sides, with right turn permitted without stopping; and that a stop sign shall be erected on Williams Street at its intersection with Milton Street, with right turn permitted without stopping. and such designations are part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
