
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of a stop sign on Tangent Street at its intersection with the West side of Second Street, requiring the traffic on Tangent Street to stop at said intersection, with right turn permitted without stopping; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A stop sign shall be erected on Tangent Street at its intersection with the West side of Second Street, and Tangent Street at said intersection is declared to be a stop street, with right turn permitted without stopping; and such designation is part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
