A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP ON A, B, C, D, AND E STREETS AT THEIR INTERSECTIONS WITH SEVENTH STREET, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF SUITABLE STOP SIGNS.

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on A, B, C, D, AND E Streets at their intersections with Seventh Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL

OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on A, B, C, D, and E Streets at their intersections with Seventh Street, on both the East and West sides of Seventh Street, and said A, B, C, D, and E Streets are declared to be stop streets; and such designations are part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 7th day of October, 1969.
