A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP ON HIATT STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH ASH STREET AND PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS. resolution no. 6
for 1969

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 36, Ordinance No. 567, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Hiatt Street at its intersection with Ash Street, requiring the traffic on Hiatt Street to stop at said intersection; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Hiatt Street at its intersection with Ash Street, on both the north and south sides of Ash Street, and Hiatt Street is declared to be a stop street; and such designation is part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
