RESOLUTION NO. 16
for 1970

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5, (4), Ordinance No. 1283, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of stop signs on Isabella Street at its intersection with Cleveland Street and on Cleveland Street at its intersection with Isabella Street, thus creating a "4-way" stop; and

WHEREAS such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL


OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Isabella Street at its intersection with Cleveland Street and on Cleveland Street at its intersection with Isabella Street, and said Isabella Street and Cleveland Street are declared to be stop streets at said intersections; and such designations are part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 18th day of August, 1970.
