A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF PARKING ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF MAIN STREET.

RESOLUTION NO. 2/ for 1970

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5 (4), Ordinance No. 1283, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the prohibition of parking on both sides of Main Street for a distance of 500 feet both North and South of the Milton Street intersection, and the prohibition of parking on both sides of Main Street from Cedar Street to the South City limits, and also has recommended the establishing of left-turn refuges at the Main Street - Milton Street intersection, all as accepted by the Oregon State Highway Division; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLPWS:

Section 1. Parking on both sides of Main Street for a distance of 500 feet both North and South of the Milton Street intersection is prohibited; and parking on both sides of Main Street from Cedar Street to the South city limits is prohibited; and the establishment of left-turn refuges as marked by the Oregon State Highway Division; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
