RESOLUTION NO. 24
for 1970

WHEREAS, pursuant to a motion passed by the Common Council, the erection of / stop sign on Fourth Street at its intersection with A Street was approved; and

WHEREAS such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBAHON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Stop signs shall be erected on Fourth Street at its intersection with A Street, and said Fourth Street is declared to be a stop street at said intersection; and such designation is part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
