A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO ) STOP ON ELMORE STREET AT ITS ) INTERSECTION WITH SECOND STREET, AND ) PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF SUITABLE) STOP SIGNS. )

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5, (4), Ordinance No. 1283, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of a stop sign on Elmore Street at its intersection with Second Street; and

WHEREAS such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> A Stop sign shall be erected on Elmore Street at its intersection with SECOND. Street, and said Elmore Street is declared to be a stop street at said intersection; and such designation is part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
