WHEREAS the territory described below is completely surrounded by the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

All of GRONSO'S FIRST AND SECOND ADDITIONS not previously annexed to the City of Lebanon; and also the property known as 387 Kees Street and more particularly described as Tax Lot 307 on Linn County Assessor's Map 12-2W-15DB.

which is completely surrounded by the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, be and the same hereby is annexed to and henceforth is a part of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.
