A RESOLUTION REQUIRING A SPEED LIMIT OF 15 MILES PER HOUR ON ACORN STREET, CEDAR DRIVE, ROSE DRIVE AND WILLOW DRIVE, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF SUITABLE SPEED LIMIT SIGNS. for 1970

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5, (4), Ordinance No. 1283, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of speed limit signs designating speeds of 15 miles per hour on Acorn Street, Cedar Drive, Rose Drive and Willow Drive; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The maximum speed on Acorn Street, Cedar Drive, Rose Drive and Willow Drive shall be 15 miles per hour, and signs designating that fact shall be erected on said streets; and such designations are part of the traffic regulation of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
