for 1970

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has filed herein plans, specifications and estimates for the street improvement district for the paving of the streets hereinafter named and described.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said plans, specifications and estimates for the paving of 6th Street from A Street to D Street; 6th Street from F Street North one-half block to the alley; F Street from 6th Street to 7th Street; Mary Street from 3rd Street to West end; Sherman Street from 7th Street to 8th Street; ~~Overhill~~ ^{ONEILL} Street from Grove Street to East end; Wassom Street from 4th Street to 2nd Street; Wendell Street from 4th Street to 2nd Street; 3rd Street from Wassom Street to Wendell Street; 2nd Street from Kees Street to Walker Road; ~~and~~ Dodge Street from Williams Street to Bromil Street, ^{and 5th St from Kees to Airport Road} including the probable total cost of said improvements and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being the property especially benefitted thereby, and the amount thereof to be borne by the City, be and they are in all respects approved, ratified and affirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said improvements be and they are hereby declared to be necessary and proper and for the best interest of the City of Lebanon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder shall cause such notice of intention to make said improvements to be given as


provided by the Charter of the City of Lebanon, said notice to be given by posting notices thereof in five public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days, or by publication of said notice in a newspaper in the City of Lebanon Oregon, for a period of ten days.
