RESOLUTION NO. 10

WHEREAS the City Engineer filed herein plans, specifications and estimates for the sewer improvement district for the construction of lateral sewers in Hansard Avenue and 9th Street from Harrison Street South a distance of approximately 780 feet; in Harrison Street from Hansard Avenue East a distance of approximately 480 feet; from Hansard Avenue East in Blocks 4 and 5 of Mountain View Addition a distance of approximately 700 feet; from Hansard Avenue East in Block 3 of Mountain View Addition a distance of approximately 300 feet; from 9th Street West in Block 2 of Nichols Addition a distance of approximately 300 feet; in Rose Street from 11th Street East a distance of approximately 260 feet; in Second Street and South Main Road from the end of existing line a distance of approximately 1200 feet; in Blocks 3 and 4 of Hall's Addition a distance of approximately 400 feet,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That said plans, specifications and estimates, including the probable total cost of said improvements and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such

being the property especially benefitted thereby, and the amount thereof to be borne by the City, be and they are in all respects approved, ratified and affirmed.

That said improvements be, and they are hereby declared to be necessary and proper and for the best interests of the City of Lebanon.

That the City Recorder shall cause such notice of intention to make said improvements to be given as provided by the Charter of the City of Lebanon, said notice to be given by posting notices thereof in five public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days, or by publication of said notice in a newspaper in the City of Lebanon for a period of ten days.
