WASSOM STREET FROM SECOND STREET WEST APPROXIMATELY 1440 FEET; FIFTH STREET FROM TANGENT STREET TO MARY STREET; HARRISON STREET FROM SECOND STREET TO FOURTH STREET; EIGHTH STREET FROM WALKER ROAD SOUTH APPROXIMATELY 1040 FEET; AZELEA DRIVE AND RHODODENDRON DRIVE (THREE BLOCKS; and HIATT STREET FROM MILTON STREET TO ELMORE STREET.

RESOLUTION NO. 12 for 1971

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has filed herein plans, specifications and estimates for the street improvement district for the paving of the streets hereinafter named and described.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That said plans, specifications and estimates for the paving of Rose Street from Tenth Street to Eleventh Street; Ninth Street from Isabella Street to CarolinaStreet; Kearn Street (one block); Second Street from Kees Street to Walker Road; Third Street from Wendell Street to Wassom Street; Wendell Street from Second Street West approximately 385 feet; Wassom Street from Second Street west арргохімаtely 440 feet; Fifth Street from Tangent Street to Mary Street; Harrison Street from Second Street to Fourth Street; Eighth Street from Walker Road south approximately 1040 feet; Azalea Drive and Rhododendron Drive (3 blocks); and Hiatt Street from Milton Street to Elmore Street, including the probable total cost of said improvements and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being the property especially benefitted thereby, and the amount thereof to be borne by the City, be and they are in all respects approved, ratified and affirmed.

That said improvements be and they are hereby declared to be necessary and proper and for the best interest of the City of Lebanon.

That the City Recorder shall cause such notice of intention to make said improvements to be given as provided by the Charter of the City of Lebanon, said notice to be given by posting notices thereof in five public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days, or by publication of said notice in a newspaper in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days.
