RESOLUTION NO. 24 for 1971

WHEREAS it is proper that the Council examine the desirability of adopting a Council-Manager form of City administration, and also study the advisability of adopting a sewer use charge; and

WHEREAS it appears advantageous to have the Mayor appoint committees to study each of these fields and report to the Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:


That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to appoint:

1. a committee to study and make recommendations in relation to the modification, amendment or re-writing of Lebanon's Charter to accomodate a manager form of government;

2. a committee to investigate and prepare a schedule of equitable sewer use charges to be adopted by the City, each of said committees to report to the Council on or before

January 4 1972.
