RESOLUTION NO. 6

WHEREAS the Street Superintendent has reported in writing to the Council that a sidewalk should be built along the south side of Elmore Street adjacent to Lot 12 Home Addition in Lebanon, also known as 370 Elmore Street,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:


That the property owner, or owners, of Lot 12 Home Addition in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be, and they hereby are, ordered to construct a sidewalk along the south side of Elmore Street adjacent to Lot 12 Home Addition. Said sidewalk shall be constructed in accordance with Ordinance No. 1311, and shall be 5 feet wide, made of concrete of not less than  $5\frac{1}{2}$  sack mix, and shall be not less than 4 inches thick except under driveways where the thickness shall be not less than 6 inches, and that said sidewalk shall be built within 30 days from the passage of this Resolution.

That the Street Superintendent and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to give notice to the adjacent property owner, or owners, as prescribed in Section 223 of the Charter of the City of Lebanon, if personal service is not given.
