RESOLUTION NO. 12 for 1972

WHEREAS the City Engineer has filed herein plans, specifications and estimates for the sewer improvement district for the construction of sanitary sewers in the area hereinafter named and described,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

That said plans, specifications and estimates for the construction of sanitary sewers north from the existing sewer in Block 4 Hall's Addition to service Lots in Block 3 Hall's Addition; in Hansard Avenue from the end of existing sewer north a distance of approximately 220 feet, including the probable total cost of said improvements and the amount thereof to be borne and paid by the owners of the adjacent or abutting property, such being the property especially benefitted thereby, and the amount thereof to be borne by the City, be and they are in all respects approved, ratified and affirmed.

That said improvements be and they are hereby declared to be necessary and proper and for the best interest of the City of Lebanon.

That the City Recorder shall cause such notice of intention to make said improvements to be given as provided by the Charter of the City of Lebanon, said notice to be given by posting notices thereof in five public places in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days, or by publication of said notice in a newspaper in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for a period of ten days.
