
RESOLUTION NO. 28
for 1972

WHEREAS, petitions have been filed by private owners, residents of the city, to gravel the alley's extending from Sixth Street to Seventh Street in the City of Lebanon, Oregon.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

That it is necessary and proper that the alley extending from Sixth Street to Seventh Street in the block between "C" and "D" Streets, being the North boundary of block one, supplemental plat, Hyland Addition, be graveled; and the City Street Department is authorized and desired to do so; and the cost thereof shall be born by the property benefited thereby.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 17th day of October, 1972.
