 TO TAKE EFFECT JANUARY 1, 1973.)

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council of the City of Lebanon deem it to be reasonable and proper to afford the electors of the City an opportunity to adopt a Council-Manager form of government, it is, therefore, necessary that the Council submit to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon at an election to be held APRIL 24th 1972, for their adoption or rejection, the proposed new Charter and repeal of the existing Charter, effective January 1, 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. That the following proposition shall be forthwith filed with the City Recorder for submission by him to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon for their approval or rejection at a special election to be held on APRIL 24th, 1972.

Section (a). That the ballot title shall be as follows:

A proposition submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon by its Common Council at a special election to be held on APRIL 24th, 1972, for the adoption or rejection of a new City Charter for Lebanon ~~establishing~~ a Council-Manager form of government and repealing all the provisions of the present City Charter, to take effect January 1, 1973.

Section (b). That the proposition shall be as follows:

Shall the proposed new City Charter ~~establishing~~ a Council-Manager form of government be adopted and all of the provisions of the present City Charter be repealed, to take effect January 1, 1973.

Section 2. That the Recorder shall publish and post notices of said election as provided by law, and shall place said proposition on the official ballot; and the establishment of polling places, the

appointment of Judges and Clerks, and the furnishing of supplies for said election shall be provided by Ordinance.


Section 3. That the vote shall be by ballot, upon which shall be the words:

"302 _____ YES, I vote for the New City Charter", and

"303 _____ NO, I vote against the New City Charter",

and the voters shall place a cross (X) or a check mark (✓) between the figure "302" and the word "Yes" or between the figure "303" and the word "No", whichever indicates his choice.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 29th day of February, 1972.
