

A RESOLUTION REQUIRING SOUTH BOUND
TRAFFIC TO STOP ON FIFTH STREET AT
ITS INTERSECTION WITH KEES STREET,
AND PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION OF
A SUITABLE STOP SIGN.)

RESOLUTION NO. 1
for 1973

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5, (5), Ordinance No. 1283, the Street Committee of the Common Council has recommended the erection of a stop sign on Fifth Street at its intersection with Kees Street; and

WHEREAS, such regulation is deemed to be reasonable and necessary for the safe movement of traffic in the City of Lebanon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL

OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A stop sign shall be erected on Fifth Street at its intersection with Kees Street, and Fifth Street is declared to be a stop street at said intersection; and such designations are part of the traffic regulations of the City of Lebanon, Oregon.
