

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE DESIGNATING OF A BUS STAND.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON AS FOLLOWS:


WHEREAS, Pursuant to the City Council direction, an investigation has been performed into the need for a bus stand, passenger loading zone, in the area of the Senior Citizen Center; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined the bus stand, passenger loading zone, will be of use to all citizens in the loading and unloading of passengers in this area; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that the general public will not suffer and loss or imposition;

THEREFORE, a BUS STAND will be created and signed as such at the first parking stall East of the alley, between Main and Park Streets, on the South side of East Ash Street. This being in the general area of 70 East Ash Street, to be more specific, a space, starting 17 feet East of the South East point of prolongation or connection of lateral curb lines of East Ash Street and the alley between Main Street and Park Street and extending 20 feet East to the location of a double parking meter pole shall be designated a BUS STAND.
